GRANT OF "ALLOWED TO WORK" STATUS IN FAVOUR OF M/S WATER, ENVIRONMENT AND SANITATION SOCIETY.

I am directed to refer to the CCAR letter F.No.3/13/Admn/CCAR/17 dated 07th May, 2019 on the above subject and to convey the approval of the competent authority to grant provisional "Allowed-to-Work" status to M/s Water Environment and Sanitation Society, a Baluchistan based NGO to work for welfare of Afghan Refugees and Host Communities on gratis basis in Balochistan for a period of six months with effect from 20-3-2019 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Allowed-to-Work status/permission will be only for welfare work for Afghan refugees (provision of facilities on gratis basis); as well as for work in connection with RAHA Programme (Hosting Areas component).
- b) The NGO will not enlist the unregistered NGOs as its members in Pakistan.
- c) The period of "Allowed-to-Work" is extendable subject to abidance by all government directives/ policies/ instructions and laws regarding NGOs in Pakistan with satisfactory performance and sound reputation, to be verified by the Serutiny Committee after expiry of the Allowed-to-Work period.
- d) The NGO will not use Wireless Equipment without valid license/permission.
- e) The NGO will not employee foreign nationals without permission of the government.
- f) The NGO will work in collaboration and coordination with concerned CAR and CCAR and inform them also before initiating any work for welfare of Afghan Refugees.
- g) The NGO will furnish quarterly and annual activities reports regularly in respect of welfare work for Afghan Refugees/Hosting Areas Component of RAHA Programme.
- h) The status of Allowed-to-Work will be withdrawn in the event of failure to abide by the above conditions.
- NGO may apply two months prior to the date of expiry to the concerned CAR/CCAR for extension if it intends to continue.
 - j) Local NGOs receiving foreign funding are required to get registered with the EAD" in terms of their Notification No. 1(5) INGO/05 dated 28th November, 2013.
